January conference 2017 at WEICON

WEICON Easy-Mix RK-7300

The all-round adhesive for plastics

We created a new adhesive that is especially suitable for bonding different types of plastic – WEICON Easy-Mix RK-7300.

It is a fast curing, solvent free structure and construction adhesive based on MMA (methyl methacrylate).

The adhesive has a high-strength and a high viscosity. It is impact resistant and withstands both static and dynamic loads.

Special fillers (glass beads), which have been added to the product, ensure a consistent bonding line of approx. 0.25 millimeters. The adhesive allows a maximum gap-bridging of one millimeter.

Bonding of plastics

The adhesive adheres perfectly on a variety of plastics and has a high adhesive strength. High-strength bondings are possible even in the case of low-energy plastics which are difficult to bond, such as PE or PP.

"RK-7300 is a universal multitalent when it comes to the bonding of a wide variety of plastics", says Holger Lütfring, Product Manager at WEICON.

The application of the new adhesive is not limited to the permanent bonding

of various plastics. Its high viscosity characteristics also permits material pairing with different expansion coefficients, such as plastic with aluminum or steel.

Many applications

The adhesive is particularly suitable for use in the plastics processing industry. RK-7300 can also be used in a variety of applications, including other areas, such as mechanical engineering or rail vehicle construction.

WEICON Easy-Mix HT 180

Reliable even at high temperatures

We have developed a special adhesive, which is characterized by its high temperature resistance and is thus suitable for applications in the field of powder coating – WEICON Easy-Mix HT 180.

The new adhesive is a 2-component epoxy resin system with a high temperature resistance up to +180°C (+356°F). Briefly, up to one hour, HT 180 can withstand temperatures up to +230°C (+446°F).

This resistance to high temperatures enables, for example, the bonding of components which are thermolacked (powder-coated) after complete curing of the adhesive.

Positive features

Easy-Mix HT 180 is characterized by many positive features, which makes it interesting for numerous applications.

It is highly viscous and stable and is also suitable for vertical applications. It is shock and impact resistant, has a long pot life, cures at room temperature and can be processed mechanically after curing. The adhesive is particularly suitable for the bonding of composite materials and metal and can be spot-welded while curing.

Wide range of applications

Easy-Mix HT 180 can furthermore be utilized for plastics, ceramic, glass, stone or wood and is suitable for bondings where larger tolerances have to be bridged. Due to special fillers it is possible to achieve a constant and reliable bonding line of at least 0.20 - 0.25 mm.

The new adhesive can be used in powder coating, metal construction, light weight construction, mechanical engineering, shipbuilding and in various areas for electrical engineering.





WEICON Rust Converter

Rust converter and base coat in one process

We have added a product to complement our range of technical sprays, a product that is ideally suited for the neutralization of rust – WEICON Rust Converter.

The Rust Converter is based on epoxy resin and forms with the neutralized rust layer a metallic-organic iron complex. The special epoxy resin stabilizes the layer, protecting in this way metals from external influences. The resulting black layer serves as base coat and is the basic layer for subsequent permanent coatings.

The spray efficiently neutralizes rust on corroded cast iron and steel surfaces. It has a strong opacity, excellent penetrating properties, protects from corrosion and is suitable for internal and external use.

The spray is temperature-resistant up to +80°C (short-term < 15 min. to +160°C),

has a good weather and UV stability as well as an excellent solvent resistance. WEICON Rust Converter is free from heavy metals and mineral-acid and neutral in odour.

Many applications

WEICON Rust Converter can be applied on all rusty parts, e. g. machines and plants, agricultural equipment as well as motor vehicles. The spray can also be used as a protective, preventive layer.

Areas of application for the new Rust Converter are, for example, plants in the petrochemical industry, in metal construction, in steel construction, in the offshore sector and in many other repair and maintenance works.

Operating instructions

The surfaces have to be dry, clean and free from dust, oil and grease.

Remove loose rust, grease, dirt and paint residue with the aid of a wire brush, grinding discs, etc. Remove the grinding dust and clean the surface, for example with WEICON Surfer Cleaner.

Carry out three or four spray cycles at a distance of 25 to 30 centimeters, observing an evaporation time of three to five minutes between the cycles. After approx. two hours, the layer is cured completely and the top coat can be applied.







Training at WEICON

Guests from the Far East

Five sales representatives from our partner Deuchman, from the People's Republic of China, visited us in Muenster in April.

The five Chinese colleagues were trained at our premises from the 19th to the 21st of April. Two days were taken to impart comprehensive background knowledge concerning our chemotechnical products, at our headquarters in Muenster. Although the sales representatives already know our large number of products from their daily work, the training provided them with a significantly more intensive insight into the theory and practical application of the adhesives, sealants, technical sprays and greases.

On the third day, our Chinese colleagues visited the production site of WEICON TOOLS in Ascheberg and were trained in competent handling of the different wire stripping tools. To date, the tools sector was almost uncharted territory for them. With the training, they were provided with important expertise that will serve them well when consulting their customers.

For the five Chinese visitors, the visit was their first trip outside of their country.

At the end of their visit, the colleagues travelled to the Hanover Fair to help at the WEICON booth and consult the Chinese visitors.

Further education at WEICON

Four new experts

Internal further education takes top priority in our company. This way, the team is always up-to-date regarding the latest technical developments and professional expertise. However, external further trainings also are an important topic in our company.

Four of our colleagues successfully completed a course at the end of the previous year and contributed important additional qualifications for our company.

Qualified professionals at WEICON

At the end of December, Martin Ligárt and Michael Kunk completed the expert training course in Berlin in accordance with § 5 Chemical Prohibition Ordinance.

This is a three-day preparatory seminar with a final written examination. The three days are highly intensive from a learning perspective since, after the seminars, which already last eight to ten hours daily, the imparted knowledge must still be repeated in the evening so as to be in a position to pass the examination.

The course covers both chemical as well as legal topics concerning the German Chemical Prohibition Ordinance. The ordinance regulates the dispensing and general handling of particularly dangerous chemicals that are also a part of our products.

The course and the examination are necessary to be permitted to sell products containing these chemicals in Germany.

After three highly strenuous and learning-intensive days with a highly comprehensive and complex course programme, our two colleagues successfully completed the examination for the expertise training in accordance with § 5 Regulation on Prohibited Chemical - prohibitions and limitations of the placing on the market of hazardous substances, preparations and products.



They were issued the certificate at the beginning of the year by the State Office for Occupational Safety, Health Protection and Technical Safety in Berlin.

Thanks to these successful qualifications, we have two more experts at WEICON who can provide the team with valuable support with their expertise.

"We would like to say thank you that we were allowed to participate in this training course and hope that we will be able to use and further deepen the acquired knowledge in the future," says Martin Ligárt, looking back at the course.





In November, Sascha Beilmann and Henning Voß also completed an important course for WEICON at DGQ (German Society for Quality) in Warendorf.


AdWords Instrument to further increase the brand awareness of the company worldwide.

Analysis of the filling behavior of adhesives in UV laser microstructures using computer tomography

Interesting results for the industry

UV laser for surface pre-treatment

The "Kunststoff-Zentrum" (SKZ) plastics centre in Würzburg investigated the suitability of UV light for the pretreatment of plastic surfaces in a comprehensive study. The treated surfaces were subsequently tested in bonding trials. Within the context of these tests, a number of our adhesives such as, e.g. RK-7100 were also tested.

During the tests, UV light was bundled to a strong UV laser, to have a targeted

impact on the surfaces that are to be treated. Here, the SKZ tests provided very interesting insights.

Laser for surface pre-treatment

It was established that the surfaces could be activated, cleaned and microstructured by pre-treatment with UV laser. As such, this method is the only


kind of pre-treatment to date where these three work steps can be completed with only one tool – UV laser.

Advantages of pre-treatment with UV light

This kind of hybrid pre-treatment is better than the established pre-treatment methods and could replace or supplement these. The pre-treatment with UV laser could be deployed with a great variety of different applications in many different industrial sectors and, for this reason, is carefully observed by numerous companies.

Another point that is attracting the interest of the industry was the bonding trials within the context of the investigation. It was demonstrated that the pre-treatment of different plastics with UV light can result in a significant increase in bonding strength. Even hard to bond plastics, such as polyoxymethylene or polypropylenes, can be bonded securely and with long-term stability.

Tensile strength of Easy-Mix RK-7100 on POM – depending on the kind of pretreatment











Square mask for the surface treatment of the plastics (left) and mask with 49 round holes for the production of microstructures (right).

However, there still is need for research in a number of areas of UV laser so as to be in a position to fully utilise the potential of the pre-treatment methods presented here in an industrial scale in the future.

Thereby, our field service colleagues can present the WEICON TOOLS to the trade association of electronic and information technology in Baden-Württemberg. All industrywide training centres of the federal state are affiliated with this association.

Trade Academy Freiburg

The academy offers a comprehensive training offering with seminars in the commercial-technical area. These seminars comprise numerous thematic fields such as metal technology, vehicle and two-wheel technology, sanitary, heating, climate and also electrotechnology and electronics.

Programme of the presentation

To start with, the business activities of WEICON were presented within the framework of a company presentation, and it was explained why a company in the chemical industry is simultaneously active on the market as a manufacturer of stripping tools.

Following the presentation of the delivery programme, the participants were trained in the practical handling of the wire strippers, cable knifes and the special tools. The seminar was concluded by a discussion round with the participants.

WEICON products subjected to test series

Lecture at the University of Osnabrück

Mid-January, our colleague Martin Ligárt, head of WEICON research and development, held a presentation at the University of Osnabrück. He followed the invitation of Prof Dr Svea Petersen, who is a lecturer in the master's course for applied material sciences in Osnabrück.

A part of this course of studies is the English-language "Polymeric Coatings and Adhesive Joints" module on the topic of adhesive technology. This module was to be ended with the presentation of the investigation results as well as a lecture about professional practice.

Taking a look at professional practice

After conducting research, Prof Petersen established contact with Martin Ligárt, who declared his willingness to offer the students an insight into the daily work routine at an adhesive manufacturer.

The presentation started with the presentation of our company. Then Martin presented our product groups to the students as well as a number of bonding samples. In closing, he

answered the students' questions and thus provided them with an additional look behind the scenes of the professional market at WEICON.

Extensive test series

The module on the topic on adhesive technology was completed by a series of tests that were performed by the students in four small groups. The presentation of the bonding tests as well as the written documentation served the purpose of determining the final grade.

Within the context of the test series, the students prepared aluminium sheeting for adhesion. They cleaned, degreased and sandblasted the parts before joining. During these tests, WEICON products were used. The WEICON Plastic Metal type C was used, the flexible adhesive and sealant Flex 310 M Classic, our cyanoacrylate adhesive VA 250 Black, as well as the structural adhesive RK-1300.

Each one of the four groups investigated one of the adhesives and used different forms of surface preparation for the adhesions. This was to establish whether the type of surface preparation had an influence on the strength properties of the adhesions and which preparation provided the best results.

To establish comparable values, tensile shear tests were performed with the aluminium sheets after the complete curing of the adhesives.

The presentations of the students followed the same pattern. To start with, the adhesive that was used was presented, as well as its history and the chemical composition. Following this, the students delivered a few application examples.


In closing, the test description followed and the presentation of the test results, which were thoroughly scrutinised by the lecturer, Prof Dr Svea Petersen, and subsequently evaluated.

"It was very interesting to exchange views with the students about daily professional life. More often than not, this opens an entirely new view on things. I am happy to pass on some of my experience that I have gained in practice to the young people," Martin Ligárt said, following the event.

WEICON Multi-Flex

Universal adhesive for many applications

We have developed a universal adhesive which is suitable for applications in many areas – WEICON Multi-Flex.

Due to these properties, the spray can be used both as coating and for numerous decorative purposes, e.g. coating of figures, decorative-articles or picture frames. It can be used for the touch up of yellow-chromatised parts after drilling, welding or milling.


target group in a simple manner and straight to the point. The drawings are made by hand and are individualised for every company.





After the official part, everyone went to the city to take a look at a number of landmarks and, in closing, enjoyed a mutual dinner to end the day in an appropriate setting.



WEICON Plastic-Bond

Bonding of plastics

We have released a new adhesive, which has its special strengths in bonding of various plastics - WEICON Plastic-Bond.

High-strength, impact resistant, residual elastic

WEICON Plastic-Bond is a solvent-free structural adhesive. It has a very good adhesion to various plastics and is also suitable for bonding other materials.

For example, plastics can also be bonded to aluminum, steel or PVC. The adhesive has a gap filling capacity of five millimeters. It has a high peel strength, is residual elastic and impact resistant and is suitable for both static and dynamic loads.

Bonding even on vertical surfaces

Plastic-Bond is particularly suitable for structural bondings where high strength connections are required. It has a high viscosity and is suitable for processing on vertical surfaces.

Use in many areas

The new structural adhesive is universally applicable and can be used, for example, in plastics technology, in metal construction, in car body and vehicle construction, in caravan construction, in mechanical engineering, in electrical engineering, in wood processing or in construction works at exhibitions.

For industrial and private applications

The adhesive has been developed for industrial applications but is also very suitable for applications in craft and DIY.

For example, the new adhesive can be used for bonding in model construction, in which plastic parts are joined together. Plastic-Bond can also carry out numerous household repairs. Light elements, such as, e.g. LED strips, can be fixed without great effort. This also allows to mount blind strips, edge protection and door signs permanently and easily.



WEICON Crack Testing Agent

Detection of flaws and cracks

Our new crack testing agent system serves the purpose of conducting a non-destructive material inspection using a dye penetrant procedure. The system consists of the WEICON Crack Testing Agent Cleaner, the Penetrant and the Developer.

However, what procedure is this, and in which industrial sectors is it deployed?

The dye penetrant inspection

The dye penetrant inspection is a widelyused procedure used to detect surface defects on building components and machines quickly, without great effort and in a non-destructive manner.

In so doing, many materials such as metals, plastics, ceramics, glass, etc., can be tested for flaws safely and reliably.

A prerequisite for the testing procedure is that the flaws are open toward the surface.

This procedure is deployed with the inspection of welding seams, cast objects, in ship-building, the automotive industry, apparatus and container construction as well as in numerous other industrial sectors.

Inspection sequence

With the dye penetrant inspection, in an initial step, the surface of the part to be inspected is cleaned to remove grease and oil residues. Once this has been completed, a penetrant agent is sprayed on.

The penetration procedure is based on the principle that, thanks to its very good creeping properties, this coloured diffusion agent will not only optimally spread on a surface; rather, it will also penetrate every crack or flaw developing from this surface.

Following a penetration period of a few minutes, which varies depending

on the material, ambient temperature and other factors, the excess diffusion agent or the agent that did not enter the flawed parts is then removed from the surface with the special cleaner. Then the developer is applied. This makes the penetrant still in the cracks and pores easily detectable again.

The developer refers to a special, finegrained powder that, owing to the capillarity of its cavities (suction effect) draws out the remaining diffusion agent that is still in the fine cracks or pores. As a consequence, cracks and flaws are clearly recognisable as visible red lines or spots.

The steps of the dye penetrant inspection at a glance

- 1. Cleaning of the surface with a special cleaner
- Spray on the penetrant and allow to react
- 3. Superficial cleaning
- 4. Apply the developer
- 5. Visual analysis





WEICON Anti-Seize Nickel

Assembly Paste for extreme conditions

We supplemented the range of assembly pastes with a special type that is suitable for use in many industrial areas – WEICON Anti-Seize Nickel.

In steel mills and cement plants, but also in power stations and in the entire chemical industry, special requirements are imposed on assembly pastes. Extreme temperatures as well as aggressive chemicals, alkalis and acids require special product properties.

Extremely resistant

Anti-Seize Nickel has been developed to resist this extreme conditions and to match the high requirements. It is highly sticky, water repellent and resistant to sweet, salt and hot water as well as steam. The high amount of nickel component furthermore provides protection against corroding and corrosive solvents which are contained in diluted hydrochloric acid, sulphur

or nitric acid, among others. Anti-Seize Nickel can be applied at a wide temperature range between -30°C (-22°F) to +1,450°C (+2,642°F).

It serves as corrosion protection and high-performance assembly paste for static and dynamically extremely stressed screw connections and installation parts. The paste is suitable for the application at slowly rotating systems in the high-temperature range.

Anti-Seize Nickel protects against corrosion, seizing, wear, stick-slip effects, oxidation and friction corrosion as well as electrolytic reactions, the so-called cold-sealing.

Anti-Seize Nickel contains selected additives as well as special solid lubricants in the smallest particle size. These lubricants guarantee the special product characteristics. The very good

separation effect is particularly effective with high-alloy steels as well as on different metals.

Suitable almost anywhere

Anti-Seize Nickel is used to solve basic problems and is not bound to any industry. Corrosion, seizure and wear are typical damages that can occur in almost all industrial areas.

It can, for example, be used on seals, valves, screw connections, gear wheels, bearings, jets, conveyor belts, stud bolts, tools or cylinders.

A safe protection of workpieces and constructions made of steel and other metals is very important for the rational and economic operation of technical installations.

Anti-Seize assembly pastes have been specially developed for these kind of requirements. They serve as protection, separation and lubricants for highly stressed parts – in particular at high temperatures. Ideal matched solids and selected additives allow a wide range of applications in almost all areas of industry.

Lubricant - corrosion protection – high content of PTFE

As a lubricating and corrosion protection agent, this product is the universal problem-solver for all moving parts in pneumatic equipment and accessories. Its special product formula with a high content of PTFE makes it a multi-purpose product for many applications: lubrication, corrosion protection, cleaning, water displacing and conservation.

Pneuma-Lub not only serves in installation or maintenance of pneumatic equipment and accessories but also can be used on pneumatic tools in operation. The excellent weathering resistance allows the use also in other sectors, e.g. in the on and offshore industry. The temperature resistance of the spray ranges from -50°C (-58°F) to +210°C (+410°F)

It can be used without any problem even under extreme weather conditions – in Siberia in the deepest winter or under the hot desert sun of Dubai.

Applications

Pneuma-Lub is suitable for the usage in many different applications. It lubricates and loosens seized pneumatic valves of engines and other parts. The spray displaces moisture in compressed air systems and accessories. It ensures long-term lubrication and also keeps

the inside of the compressed air system clean. Pneuma-Lub protects and preserves pneumatic equipment, even under extreme conditions, and keeps it operational.

The spray can be used in road construction, in workshops, in vehicle construction, in open pit mining, in the extraction of raw materials, and wherever pneumatic tools are used.

Spray Pneuma-Lub during installation, maintenance and repairs. Spraying is possible even on running equipment while observing safety regulations. Behind the scenes

Application videos at WEICON

WEICON has more than 350 different products-adhesives, sealants, technical sprays and many more. We also have a great number of application videos on these products.

Even if most videos don't last longer than one to two minutes – their production involves a number of hours.

The purpose of application videos

Our application videos fulfil numerous purposes: On the one hand, they are a visual instruction manual demonstrating the right processing of the product step-by-step. As such, they serve as an orientation aid and have the purpose of helping to avoid application errors.

On the other, they are used for training our employees. And they can also be deployed as presentation aids for our

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products at customers. All application videos are produced in a German and an English version.

Step by step to the final video

During a first step, it has to be clarified which applications are to be demonstrated with the respective product. With our cyanoacrylates, better known as super glues, there are, e.g. a great number of possibilities. With other products, the number of applications is slightly more restricted.

Here, first and foremost, Mike Breitenfeld from our applications engineering department is called upon. He regularly comes up with new applications, be it for our adhesives, technical sprays or sealants.

The right filming location

Many of our application videos are filmed at customers. Generally speaking, one of our sales representatives makes an appointment. Our WEICON film crew then travels to the respective company and starts working. The team consists of our camera woman, Laura Schönfleisch, Mike Breitenfeld, the responsible area sales manager and another person who takes photos of the application alongside. It also shouldn't be more than four persons, because otherwise, it would simply be too many. Everything must then be done and dusted in approx. 15 to 30 minutes so as not to disrupt the work on site.

The right sequence is crucial!

After the recordings, Laura starts by viewing the material in her office and does an initial sorting and removal of material that cannot be used; this refers to material that is fuzzy or blurred or also sequences in which the application was not quite one hundred percent.



Then it's Mike's turn, and he decides which sequence will ultimately be used. Laura uses this to cut the video. When the rough cut is done, texts from the instruction manual are still added as well as the technical data of the product. Subsequently, the video is once again inspected by Mike regarding the technical data and the correct presentation of the application. Then the text is proofread and a look is taken at layout and cut once again.

Once the video has received the final release by all persons, it can





be uploaded on our website, in the WEICON app as well as on our YouTube channels.

Time expenditure

In most cases, two to four weeks are still needed from the planning stage to uploading. On the day of shooting itself, about one hour is needed, plus the trip to and from the film location. For postis needed for subsequent corrections and coordination to ensure the best possible result.

Thus, behind a short video there is much more effort than possibly imagined at first glance. However, it is still worth the while, because the application videos offer not only WEICON, but also our customers and interested parties true added value!





Review of the first season of collaboration

WEICON as the main sponsor for Tri Finish Muenster

Since January 2016, WEICON has acted as the main sponsor and namesake for the Muenster Triathlon club "WEICON Tri Finish Muenster". The collaboration has been signed for 24 months with an option of one further year. In 2017, the club's men's team is to go into its fifth season in the Triathlon top league.

The triathlon club, which was founded in 1985, has grown in size to more than 250 members as the popularity of the triathlon endurance sport increases, and is amongst other things in the first and second triathlon Bundesliga (National League) of the German Triathlon Union (DTU) and is represented in the league system of the North Rhine-Westphalian Triathlon Association ev. (NRWTV). The top men's team starts in the first league. The Muenster-based club is represented

by both a men's and a women's team in the second league.

The biggest success for the club has been the men's team reaching the Bundesliga, where the team has remained since 2013.

The first season of collaboration

After the first season with WEICON as their new main sponsor, the athletes in Tri Finish can look back on a highly successful year 2016.

The Bundesliga Men's Team was able last year to take a strong ninth place - of the 16 teams competing in

the league. The American Seth Rider caused a sensation last year by taking second place at the event in Ingolstadt – never before has a Tri Finish athlete succeeded in achieving one of the top 3 places.

In the second league, the teams started the 2016 season with the targets of TOP 10 (men) and TOP 8 (women) in the 2016 season. In the end, the women achieved an indescribably strong fourth place and thus become the surprise team of the 2016 season. The men landed squarely in tenth place – right on target!



Perspectives for the 2017 season

In the coming season, the men's Bundesliga Team will feature five new triathletes. Within the league, team fluctuations are high as young sportspeople are for vocational or study reasons frequently unable to find sufficient time to carry out the intensive triathlon competition preparations, and have to withdraw from the team accordingly.

The Tri Finish men's squad consists in total of twelve athletes who will be starting the race for the cathedral city in 2017. In this season, too, the main objective is to stay in the same class.





"If possible in single figures, as with our ninth place last year. I think the possibilities open to us do not make anything else feasible" says Tim Habel, Sports Director for Tri Finish, in a realistic assessment of the targets for the coming season.

The Triathlon Bundesliga

Within the scope of the DTU Bundesliga, the winning German teams are determined annually for women and for men. For this purpose, five races across a sprinting distance will also be conducted in 2017 (750 meters swim, 20 kilometers bike ride, five kilometers run). The men's teams consist of five athletes and the women's teams of four athletes respectively.

The Bundesliga season will officially start on 10th June in Kraichgau am Hardtsee in Ubstadt-Weiher. It will continue on 23rd June in Muenster, where the Tri Finish team will play a home game. After that, the season will continue with further competitions on 6th August in Tuebingen and on 20th

August in Grimma. The final will take place on 9th September and will be carried out for the first time in Binz, on Ruegen.

The WEICON logo has been integrated

Tri Finish is one of the largest triathlon clubs in NRW; and offers activities both for amateur and competitive athletes as well as for all hobby sportspeople interested in triathlons. Members can take part in swimming, cycling and running training and in association events, and can exchange information with likeminded people.

In addition, Tri Finish acts as the organiser for large-scale sporting events such as the "Sparda-Muenster-City-Triathlon", for which WEICON acts as the official sponsor. In addition to the usual advertising mediums, banners and flags, the WEICON logo is also featured on the competitive sports clothing of the Tri Finish league teams.

On the occasion of the 10th anniversary, a very special box has been developed, which could be requested by our customers. The box contained the WEICON Contact cyanoacrylate adhesive VA 8312, the anaerobic adhesive and sealant WEICONLOCK AN 302-43 as well as a practical bottle opener in the design of the Pen-System.

In Germany, Austria and Luxembourg, our customers' attention was drawn to the campaign with an e-mail, and they could request the set. This way, more than 1,200 sets were sent to our German-speaking customers.

Our branches distributed more than 1,000 sets and our export division sent out almost 950 sets. Thus, all in all, worldwide, more than 3,100 Pen sets were sent out – a great number!

Overall, a highly successful campaign. We are now already looking forward to the next ten years with our Pen-System!






What was the last TV series you watched?


I really enjoy watching "Das perfekte Dinner", whenever I find the time.
